All residents of St. Paul's Towers are automatically members of the St. Paul's Towers Residents' Association. The group annually elects a 7-member Residents' Council that regularly meets with the Executive Director. The Council serves as a liaison between Administration and residents on issues of concern to the entire community. Its purpose is to promote the wellbeing of residents and expand opportunities for active participation in the community. A number of resident committees function in every aspect of resident life and provide leadership to enhance the quality of life at St. Paul's Towers. All residents are invited and welcome to join committees.
