

RESIDENTS' COUNCIL INFORMATION

The St Paul's Towers Residents' Council meets monthly on the second Monday of each month at 1:30 PM in the Residents' Center. Four of these meetings are designated Association Meetings and all residents are invited to vote during these meetings.

Seven Council members are elected by the residents for a 2-year term. The term of office begins in January and the number of Council members elected each year varies from three to four so that nearly half of the Council is rotated out each election. In October, the President appoints a nominating committee of three residents who solicit candidates for election to the Council.

The Council members elect the President, Vice-President, Treasurer, and Secretary of the Council each year. Council members consider issues presented to them by residents and make decisions by voting on these issues.

Residents are encouraged to attend the meetings but do not vote at Council meetings. Residents are observant guests and may be called on to speak during the meetings. As mentioned previously, at the four Association meetings each year (normally scheduled for January, April, August and December) residents have the opportunity to vote.

Open Forum is held at the end of each monthly meeting and residents are welcome to comment and ask questions. The Council serves in an advisory capacity to the Management of SPT.
